

Community/Labor Briefings on the Anti-Middle Class “Right to Work” Constitutional Amendment

The Minnesota legislature has convened and legislators are making decisions that affect our unions.

Unfortunately, corporate CEOs who have taken away union rights in other states now want to weaken workers' rights in Minnesota – they want to tamper with our constitution by passing an anti-middle class amendment mislabeled “Right to Work.”

The name “Right to Work” is a blatant deception. It would not guarantee any rights or create any jobs. In states with these laws, the average worker makes \$5,500 less each year than Minnesota workers.

Our legislators need to hear from us that we want them to focus on fixing our economy – not pushing a corporate special agenda to weaken unions and the middle-class.
