#### Dear Members,

In the last issue of *Keeping Current*, I introduced myself to those who don't know me and reintroduced myself to those who may have forgotten me while I was less involved with this great local union. This issue, I would like to talk about something I have observed after returning as an employee of the 292 office, and I would like to discuss the visions I have for our union and the things we can do to improve the quality of our Brotherhood.

It seems we have, in several instances, become complacent in many of the tasks we perform on a daily basis. I do not say this to harp on anybody in particular; I say it as a general observation. As I write this, I am thinking of the Minnesota IBEW member who nearly lost his life on the job yesterday, the Minnesota IBEW apprentice who was recently injured by electric shock, and the far too many members who have lost their lives while at work.

We must change the culture on the job to one of a "safety first" mentality. This great brotherhood was formed on the basis of safety because too many of our early electrical workers were dying on the job. Brothers and Sisters, please work safely! Turn circuits off and lock them out while working on them, de-energize equipment and fixtures, and always wear the proper personal protective equipment while working on a job site. I do not want to hear any more stories of IBEW members being injured on the job. If we all focus on safety, no one will get hurt.

Now, my visions for this Local are simple. First, I want to ensure that every member who leaves their house for work safely returns to their family after "a fair day's work for a fair day's pay." Taking safety seriously will accomplish this vision. Next, I would like to see each and every member taking great pride in what they do every day. Giving "eight for eight" in a journeyperson-like manner will help accomplish this. Finally, I want to see every member participating in their union. This union is not possible without you!

Remember: Work safely and turn it off. I look forward to seeing you at our next meeting.


