WORK PICTURE INFORMATION, BENEFIT FORMS, AND LOCAL NEWS

Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

As we settle into winter here in the frozen tundra of Minnesota, our work opportunities for members on the out-of-work list continue to be limited in our jurisdiction. Although the outlook from our employers seems quite optimistic for spring and summer, the work picture is slow right now.

Anyone who is registered on the out-of-work list and looking to go to work in another jurisdiction should contact our hiring hall. There are still opportunities to work in other Locals while waiting for our Local work picture to improve. As always, we thank all the local unions who provide work for our members.

Currently, we are exploring and signing Project Labor Agreements ("PLAs") that cover work at several jobsites within our jurisdiction. The amount of work projected by our contractors, coupled with the PLAs being presented and signed, should bring increased opportunities in Local 292's jurisdiction for many of our members.

I have spoken with several members regarding healthcare benefit forms that are required to be submitted to the benefits office on an annual basis. I understand that these forms can be cumbersome, but the fact is, the information submitted on these forms is required to ensure that we maintain the best possible healthcare benefits at the most competitive cost available. If you have not done so already, please get your spousal coverage and adult dependent forms submitted to the benefits office as soon as possible so healthcare coverage does not lapse on any of your loved ones.

Additionally, for members participating in the personal savings plan, covered under the inside agreement, please submit your account information to the benefits office so your personal savings monies can be deposited in a timely fashion. If you have any questions about any of the benefit forms, please contact our Local 292 benefits office.

Local 292 has hired an additional organizer in the metro office and we will be hiring one more to work out of the St. Cloud office. Our goal with these additional organizers is to increase work opportunities for all our members. Recently, Local 292 was successful in demonstrating majority status for a group of electrical workers at a local manufacturing plant. We look forward to negotiating with this company and working to reach a fair and equitable contract for this new bargaining unit. Negotiations are ongoing with several other signatory employers as well. We have open contracts at many of our public sector employers, broadcasting employers, and manufacturing employers. We will continue to work diligently at negotiating agreements for all our members working at these employers.

As we move through this winter, please stay safe. I look forward to seeing you at our next Union meeting.

Hello Brothers and Sisters of IBEW Local 292

The Minnesota Legislature is now in session. Legislators began their work this year with a \$7.5 billion surplus. There are as many ideas on how to use that surplus as there are residents in Minnesota. In addition to that surplus, Governor Walz is proposing a \$2.7 billion bonding bill; with interest rates as low as they are, now is the time to borrow money for capital improvement/construction projects. We also expect a large portion of federal infrastructure money to come to Minnesota, including money for electric vehicle infrastructure. With all the combined revenue sources, we will be pushing for state- and federally-financed construction projects this legislative session.

In addition to supporting spending on construction projects, we will continue to defend against any changes to the Minnesota Electrical Act that would affect licensing, reciprocity, inspection, classifications, and apprenticeship ratios, and we will oppose any changes to standards and regulations that would be detrimental to our industry.

2022 is an important election year. All Minnesota legislators and constitutional officers, including governor, are up for election this year, as are all our U.S. Congressional Representatives. Also, this year, new federal and state legislative lines will be drawn, which will present even more of a political challenge. We will need to start early and work hard to make sure our collective labor voices are heard and to secure a labor-friendly majority at the Minnesota capitol as well as to help re-elect Tim Walz to another 4-year term as governor. With Tim Walz at the helm of the administration, we have been able to hold back a number of anti-worker, antielectrical industry legislative attacks. We have been able to garner favorable outcomes for appointments of Department Commissioner and committee and board members that have served us well throughout the state and helped our industry. Without securing a labor-friendly majority, without re-electing Tim Walz, I have no doubt that we will see a steady stream of anti-worker and anti-electrical industry legislation and administrative action against us, including Right to

Work. We DO NOT want to become Wisconsin. Our anti-labor enemies are poised to put us there.

This year, more than any other, please consider getting involved to help our labor family gain the recognition and support we need to maintain and improve a great standard of living and to gain respect in the workplace, on the jobsite, at home, and in our communities.

I want to let you know of some important events and opportunities this year that you can participate in to help our collective IBEW Local 292 labor voice be heard.

January 31: Start of MN Legislative Session

February 1: Statewide Precinct Caucuses

February 15: Deadline for new legislative districting lines to be drawn

Late February – April: Senate District, Organizing Unit and Congressional District Endorsing Conventions

Mid-May: Political parties' state conventions in Rochester

May 17: Candidate filing starts

May 23: End of MN Legislative Session

August 9: Statewide Primaries

November 8: Election Day


News From the JATC





