FROM THE BUSINESS MANAGER'S PERSPECTIVE

Sisters and Brothers -

Working Outside Local 292's Jurisdiction, Pride in our Work, Upcoming Contract Negotiations, and a Few Announcements

We have long-established rules within the IBEW that speak to the working etiquette for members who are asked to report to job sites outside our jurisdiction. These work rules have been established to preserve the autonomy of each individual local union. They are part of what makes the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers a premier trade union. When leaving Local 292's jurisdiction, at the direction of your employer, remember that our Local 292 agreements are no longer enforceable and that, when in another jurisdiction, you are working under the terms and conditions of the local where the job site is located. The terms and conditions of employment in another local union jurisdiction can significantly differ from what we have negotiated here within Local 292. If traveling to another local union's jurisdiction, please check in with their union hall and strictly adhere to the working terms and conditions that they have negotiated. Local 292 members have historically been very well received by other local unions, and it is our job to maintain that reputation. Our reputation precedes us, and I expect that we all do our part to ensure that those behind us enjoy the benefits of this same reputation.

Local 292 labor agreements contain some of the best wages and working conditions in the entire labor movement. We have fought hard over the years to secure our contracts, and it is up to us to deliver on our end of the Agreement. Essentially, when we go to work, we are trading time for money. As your elected Business Manager, my job is to help negotiate employment agreements that ensure our members are making a fair trade. When working under these agreements, we need to deliver the goods. We need to provide our employers with "eight [quality] hours of work for eight hours of pay." In addition to this trade, I ask that all members perform their daily work in a manner that makes us all proud. In order to continue to demand the highest wages and benefit packages, we need to be the best electrical workers in the industry. Take pride in your work; after all, you have been trained to be the best in the industry. Let's keep proving that we are the best!

As 2023 ends, we look forward to upcoming challenges in 2024. Our Inside Construction and Maintenance Agreement including the Twelve-County Addendum and the Minnesota Statewide Limited Energy Agreement, are up for renegotiation. If you have suggestions regarding things you would like to see included in the negotiation proposals for these Agreements, please log into our website (ibew292.org) and click the "SUBMIT NEGOTIATION SUGGESTIONS" button. Here, you will find a fillable form to submit your suggestions to the negotiating committees. We are an organization that is only as strong as our members, and we need your suggestions for these contracts to make us stronger.

In the coming weeks, Local 292 will be starting an addiction recovery meeting for our members. If you are interested in participating in this meeting, please contact the office for date, time, and location information.

Additionally, going forward, the Local 292 representatives and I will be contacting all our members via phone. This call is simply a check-in to see how you are doing. We look forward to chatting with each of you!

The 2023-2024 school year is off to a great start, with a full lineup of continuing education courses scheduled. The round robin Code class is a great way to get your CE credits with various subjects and instructors, and lunch will be provided. We are looking to add an estimating class later this winter, we will update the website once this class is available.

The MN Department of Labor and Industry recently released grant funding for the Labor Education Advancement (LEAP) Grant. The JATC presented a grant request and was awarded **\$100,000.00** as part of the Grant. The Grant's intent for the JATC is to hire a Workforce Development Coordinator (WDC).

There are many challenges for new apprentices entering our industry, just as many of us faced when we came into the industry. Not everyone starts in the industry with the same background, resources, knowledge, and mechanical abilities, and it can be a significant challenge for a variety of new apprentices trying to succeed.

The goal of the WDC will be to assist in diversifying the program through recruitment efforts, mentoring, and retention goals by working with applicants and apprentices in the program. The WDC is a needed position and role at the JATC, and we are fortunate to receive the Grant from MN DLI to support this work.

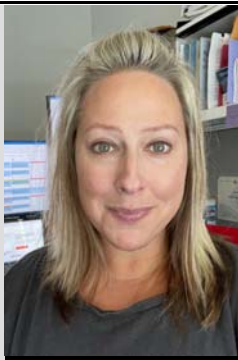

FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S DESK

The letter below is an example of what you will receive if you are more than 3 months in arrears. Please read the below letter and understand what you and your family will lose as a delinquent member.

It is heartbreaking having to tell a member, whether they have five-years or twenty-five years of service they are no longer eligible for any PBF benefit and will have to start over as a new member.

MEMBERS IN ARREARS

Dear 25 Year Member:

You are currently 3 months in arrears in your local union dues. Please be advised that as an "A" member, you are in danger of losing eligibility for the PBF benefits for which you have been making contributions.

Under Article XI, Section 6(a) of the IBEW Constitution, eligibility for PBF benefits is based on continuous good standing in the IBEW. Any member who is dropped from membership after six (6) months' delinquency in per capita tax payments, or who has accepted honorary withdrawal status, shall not be in good standing for purposes of determining eligibility for, and in computing the amount of, PBF benefits.

Further, under Article XI, Section 4(a) of the IBEW Constitution, no death benefit is payable upon the death of a nonretired "A" member if such member was more than two (2) months in arrears in per capita tax payments, unless it can be demonstrated that the arrearage was not the fault of the member in which case the death benefit is reduced by the amount of the arrearage. Please pay your dues as soon as possible so that you do not lose your eligibility for PBF benefits.
